THE COALITION TO END RELATIONSHIP ABUSE REMEMBERS APOSTLE L MINNESOTA'S 23RD CONFIRMED VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE-RELATED HOMICIDE IN 2024

Apostle L, 61, was killed in a car crash on or around December 13, 2024. Nicholas Price, 37, is charged with one count of fleeing a police officer resulting in someone's death and one count of criminal vehicular homicide, in addition to charges for threats of violence and domestic assault by strangulation. On the night of December 13, Price's ex-girlfriend called police to report that he had shoved her against a wall, strangled her, and threatened to light her on fire. Several hours later, police spotted Price's vehicle in Roseville and attempted to conduct a traffic stop to pull him over for the domestic assault, but Price fled. As more police officers joined the pursuit, Price continued to flee. He reached speeds of 50–60 miles per hour over the speed limit without his lights on, and eventually crashed into Apostle's car in Maplewood. Apostle was trapped in the car and told officers he couldn't breathe. He was removed from the car and transported to the hospital, where he later died. **We remember Apostle L.**
