THE COALITION TO END RELATIONSHIP ABUSE REMEMBERS ANDREA "DREA" BROYLD MINNESOTA'S 22ND CONFIRMED VICTIM OF INTIMATE PARTNER HOMICIDE IN 2024

Andrea "Drea" Broyld, 41, was shot and killed inside a home in Red Wing on November 17, 2024. Darryl Nixon Jr., 41, is charged with one count of seconddegree murder. Andrea was in a relationship with Nixon Jr. and they were issued a marriage license in August. Police were called to Nixon Jr.'s home on November 17 after Nixon Jr. allegedly informed the caller that Andrea had been shot and was "gone." When police arrived, Nixon Jr. made more comments about shooting Andrea, and then locked himself in his residence, prompting a three hour standoff before surrendering. Andrea was then found dead inside the home. She had been shot 10 times.

Andrea "Drea" Broyld, who worked at Starbucks, was described as "one of the nicest people ever, always greeting people with a smile and writing encouraging notes on your cup to start your day."
