THE COALITION TO END RELATIONSHIP ABUSE REMEMBERS ROLAND CHALMOUS HOPEWELL MINNESOTA'S 28TH CONFIRMED VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE-RELATED HOMICIDE IN 2021.

WE REMEMBER

Roland Chalmous Hopewell, 36, was shot and killed in Minneapolis on September 25, 2021. Myshun S.C. Logan, 38, was charged with second-degree murder in 2021 and in December 2024 agreed to plead guilty. Roland was in a relationship with Logan's ex-girlfriend. Roland's girlfriend was pregnant with Roland's child at the time of the shooting. Roland's girlfriend told police that Logan found them outside a shop in Minneapolis as they were leaving, and began arguing with them before shooting Roland at close range. She also told police that Logan had assaulted Roland two weeks prior and had threatened to kill them both.

Roland Chalmous Hopewell, 36, leaves behind at least two children. Roland was described as the "funniest guy I knew, great personality," "Funny and loved to laugh," and great at his job.
