Toumai Gaynor, 21, was shot and killed in St. Paul on May 30, 2024. Martavious Roby-English, 21, faces second-degree murder and attempted second-degree murder charges. Roby-English's ex-girlfriend had been in a car with Toumai that night. She told police that Roby-English had grown progressively more upset that she wasn't coming over and was angry that she had turned her location off as "it was a sign of mistrust." At one point Roby-English sent his ex-girlfriend a text threatening to walk over and shoot her. His ex-girlfriend and a witness stated that Roby-English eventually ran up to the car she was in with Toumai and repeatedly yelled "Get out of the car or I will kill you" before shooting, killing Toumai. After the shooting, Roby-English claimed to police that he had later learned Toumai had been dating his ex-girlfriend. Prosecutors believe he was attempting to kill his ex-girlfriend during the shooting. Roby-English has a history of assault charges for prior shootings.
